

## **Prof. Benno Ndulu – Chairing the Panel Discussion**

Professor Benno Ndulu is the Governor of the Central Bank of Tanzania. Prior to this, he worked as a Lead Sector Specialist with the Macroeconomic Division of the World Bank for Eastern Africa from the Tanzania Country Office. He is best known for his involvement in setting up and developing one of the most effective research and training networks in Africa, the African Economic Research Consortium.



Professor Ndulu received an honorary doctorate from the ISS in the Hague in recognition of his contributions to Capacity Building and Research on Africa in 1997. Following his Ph.D. degree in economics from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois, he taught economics at the University of Dar es Salaam, was Executive Director of the African Economic Research Consortium in Nairobi and has published widely on growth, adjustment, governance and trade.
