## **REPOA's Resource Centre to be open on Mondays starting January 2012**



REPOA's library was established right after the beginning of REPOA's operation in 1995, and has been growing over more than a decade now. In 2010, the library was converted into a resource centre, offering a wider range of digital and print information resources relevant and useful for development research, training. Following an increase in demand from visitors for the use of the resource centre which was only open to the public from Tuesday to Friday, effective January 2012 the resource centre will also be open on Mondays.

The library is free and open to all members of the community.
