Afrobarometer

Afrobarometer is a pan-African, nonpartisan survey research network that provides reliable data on African experiences and evaluations of democracy, governance, and quality of life. Seven rounds of surveys were completed in up to 38 countries between 1999 and 2018. Round 8 surveys (2019/2021) covered 34 countries. Afrobarometer conducts face-toface interviews in the language of the respondent's choice.

The Afrobarometer team in Tanzania, led by REPOA interviewed a nationally representative, random, stratified probability sample of 2,398 adults in February-March 2023. A sample of this size yields country-level results with a margin of error of +/-2 percentage points at a 95% confidence level. Previous surveys were conducted in Tanzania in 1999, 2001, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2012, 2014, and 2017.
